I can assess the reason why Japan launched their attack on Pearl Harbor and brought the United States into WWII.

1. The Pearl Harbor Attack

Japanese Expansion –

-As war continued in Europe, Japan continued its expansion in Asia -After Japan occupied Indochina, Roosevelt froze all Japanese assets in the US -Roosevelt also issued an embargo on gasoline and steel for Japan

Japan Plan's An Attack –

<u>October 1941</u> -

-Minister of War Hideki Tojo, became prime minister

-Tojo was committed to expansion and wanted to attack the United States

November 20, 1941 -

-Japanese peace mission visited Washington D.C.

-Demanded the US unfreeze Japanese assets, supply Japan's gas needs, and cease all aid to China

The US Breaks The Code -

-US had broken the secret code used to send messages to the Japanese embassy from Tokyo -US knew Japan planned to attack but they didn't know where or when

The Attack on Pear Harbor -

December 7, 1941 -

-Shortly before 8:00 AM the Japanese attacked the US naval base at Pearl Harbor -The core of the US Pacific Fleet was anchored at Pearl Harbor -Over 100 US planes were also located at Pearl Harbor

Destruction -

-20 US warships and 200 aircrafts were destroyed-2,400 Americans were killed (1103 entombed on the USS Arizona)

American Reaction -

-The bombing shocked the country and Roosevelt addressed the nation -He labeled Dec. 7 as "a date which will live in infamy" -Called on Congress to pass a declaration of war against Japan
